# Why Dual Credit at Salem Academy?



Salem Academy offers almost two full years' worth of college credit at a small fraction of the cost of university through our Dual Credit program. All credits are earned through Corban University and Northwest Nazarene University, accredited four-year programs whose courses transfer easily to other institutions throughout the region. These courses are taught on our campus, in small classes, by our caring faculty who know your student personally.

## FOR EXAMPLE: Dual Credit transfer to George Fox University

- Salem Academy student takes Honors US History, Pre-Calculus, Honors English III, and Biology II in 11<sup>th</sup> grade, then takes Honors Government, Calculus, Anatomy, Spanish IV, and Honors Public Speaking in 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- GFU will accept all 43 semester credits, 28 of which can fulfill core undergraduate requirements. **This student is now considered a Sophomore in the GFU undergraduate program!**
- Current cost to the family: \$3,300 in Dual Credit tuition while attending Salem Academy.
- Estimated cost of one year of college at GFU: \$52,220 for tuition, books, room, and board.
- **This family saved over \$48,000, a full year of the student's time and the added financial benefit of starting employment one year early!**

## FOR EXAMPLE: Dual Credit transfer to Oregon State University

- Salem Academy student takes Honors US History, Pre-Calculus, Honors English III, and Biology II in 11<sup>th</sup> grade, then takes Honors Government, Calculus, Anatomy, Spanish IV, and Honors Public Speaking in 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- OSU will accept all 47 quarter credits, 36 of which can fulfill core undergraduate requirements. **This student is now considered a Sophomore in the OSU undergraduate program!**
- Current cost to the family: \$3,300 in Dual Credit tuition while attending Salem Academy.
- Estimated cost of one year of college at OSU: \$27,304 for tuition, books, room, and board.
- **This family saved over \$24,000, a full year of the student's time and the added financial benefit of starting employment one year early!**
